Page 105 (After Finale):

(All actors on stage freeze)

Narrator: Well, folks, we have reached the end of young Charlie's tale. In the end, Charlie Bucket won a chocolate factory. But Willy Wonka got something even better. A family. As a matter of fact, that very day, Grandpa George, Grandma Georgina, Grandma Josephina, Grandpa Joe, Mister and Mrs. Bucket, and Charlie all packed up their things and moved into the factory. They spent their days helping the brilliant and wonderful Mr. Wonka bring his dreams to life. And one thing was absolutely certain - life had never been sweeter. (*Put "Wonka" hat on head and pose*).

CANDY KID LINES: Page 13:

Narrator: *(to the audience)* See these kids? They meet outside Charlie's house every day after lunch, with a shiny nickel apiece to buy a Wonka Bar from the local Candy Man. The only kid with no nickel is Charlie.

(the sound of the Candy Man's cart approaching is heard.)

Candy Man Kids: It's the Candy Man! (ad-libbing)

Matilda: What are you going to get?

Nancy: I would like the grape-flavored jelly beans! My Aunt Vicki says they're the tops! What about you, Thomas?

Thomas: I really want the snap-crackle-pop strawberry gobstoppers. They're to die for!

Arthur: Well, you haven't lived 'til you have had a sour lemon lick-'em-ade! They guarantee to give you a sour face for 24 hours!

Mary: My favorite is the melt-in-your-mouth mallomars!

Arthur (Cast One Only): You're crazy! The caramel fudge clusters are the way to go!

James: *(slurping a lollipop)* Hey Charlie, help me pick something out. I got a nickel.

Matilda: You've already got a lollipop. Shouldn't you finish it first?

James: I can't help it! I love candy! All candy! Chocolate, caramel, jawbreakers, suckers...

Charlie: Stop it! You're making my mouth water! (#5 <u>The Candy Man</u> begins).

Wonka: All of my workers are Oompa-Loompas from Loompaland. Why don't you all introduce yourselves to our guests?

Oompa-Loompa 1: My name is Bubbly Snowbell Bottom. At your service. (*He salutes/gestures*).

Oompa-Loompa 2: My name is Gumdrop Grumples.(*He salutes/gestures*).

Oompa-Loompa 3: My name is Zippy PittlePatter.(*He salutes/gestures*).

Oompa-Loompa 4: My name is Dumpling Picklehat.(*He salutes/gestures*).

Oompa-Loompa 5: My name is Crumples Rainbow Dust. (He salutes/gestures).

Oompa-Loompa 6: My name is Syrup Treacle Tart. (*He salutes/gestures*).

Oompa-Loompa 7: And I'm Jolly Bum Magic Bow Sparkly Dust Pepper Mint Dollop Cream I Can't Believe It's Not Butter... the third. *(He salutes/gestures)*.

(All Oompa-Loompas strike a group pose. Charlie begins clapping, but he looks around and realizes no one else is joining in).

Wonka: That's nice of you Charlie, but the Oompa-Loompas aren't used to applause. (*to Oompa-Loompas*) Alright, back to work!

Page 82:

Charlie: Grandpa Joe, what's that?

Oompa-Loompa 1: Try it!

Charlie: Who's there? Hello?

Oompa-Loompa 2: Try it!

Oompa-Loompa 3: Try it!

Grandpa Joe: Should we?

Oompa-Loompa 4: Have a taste!

Oompa-Loompa 5: Just a little sip!

Oompa-Loompas 6 and 7: You'll love it!

Charlie: Well, I suppose one tiny taste wouldn't do any harm. (Grandpa Joe takes one drink. #40 - Flying begins.)
